"Tour For Kids" - Ride Somewhere Meaningful!

This summer, hundreds of cyclists will help raise money for children's cancer camps in Ontario including Camp Oochigeas, Camp Quality and Camp Trillium. This fantastic journey will see cyclists touring around central Ontario, linking the very camps that will benefit! Not only will cyclists Ride Somewhere Meaningful™, but they will also be able to ride FOR something meaningful... every cyclist will dedicate each segment of their journey to someone who is battling or has survived cancer or to honour the memory of someone special. Cyclists will ride at their own pace over designated scenic rural routes that reach into beautiful cottage country, enjoying rest stops, police escorts and other help along the route. Each day will end with a dinner and celebration hosted by one of the camps. Riders will have the option to sign up to ride all four segments (~800 Km), a single segment (ranging from 175 Km to 225 Km), or smaller portions of a single segment (100 Km). Local riders are encouraged to join in for the last 15 kilometers on each day. Starting on August 12 in Toronto, riders will visit Camp Quality in Markdale, Camp Oochigeas in Muskoka/Haliburton, Camp Trillium near Trenton, ending at Camp Quality in Lanark, near Ottawa on Sunday August 15.
